

Volume One By Your Grace Anything is Possible

Sheriar Foundation is pleased to announce release of the first of the three-volume series, Befitting a Fortunate Slave, Meber Baba's Eruch.


VOLUME ONE, By Your Grace Anything is Possible, covers the period in Eruch's life from his birth in 1916 up to the New Life in 1949. This 756-page hardcover edition includes more than ninety photographs.

VOLUME TWO, By His Side, reflects on the change in Eruch's life that began with the New Life. During this time, Baba no longer sent him back to the family to stay for long periods, calling him when needed. Eruch was now full time in the ashram. It begins with the New Life in 1949 and ends in 1956 with Baba's second accident. We will announce the release date as we get closer to it.

VOLUME THREE, A Day Will Come, begins in 1956, in the aftermath of the second accident, and ends with Baba dropping His body and Eruch's passing

on August 31, 2001. The title of the last volume in this epic trilogy refers to Baba's promise to Eruch that "Just as today you pulled Me out of these filthy waters, a day will come when I will give you MY hand and pull you out of the filth of illusion."

The three couplets quoted on the right, and from which the title of this book was chosen, have special relevance in the Baba world. On January 31, 1969, when Meher Baba was in the last few hours of His life, as He conversed and joked with those around Him, in between the agonizing spasms that racked His body, Aloba, one of the men mandali, entered His room carrying a large board upon which were printed these three couplets. In the intense atmosphere of Baba's

I am the slave of the Master, who has released me from ignorance. Whatever my Master does is of the highest benefit to all concerned.



NEW FILM FOOTAGE OF MEHER BABA DISCOVERED



Meher Baba in the Samadhi

A five and a half minute, original 16-mm film of Meher Baba was discovered in Myrtle Beach this year. The film shows Baba in the Samadhi after He dropped His physical form. It is similar to footage in the Entombment film by Don Stevens, however, Baba is seen from a different angle. This footage has been digitized and will be preserved in cold storage.

The film was hand-carried to Cambridge, Massachusetts, by a team of Baba lovers who lovingly cared for and delivered their precious cargo to the lab, keeping it cool and comfortable.

The image shown above was taken from this newly digitized film.

An announcement will be sent by Sheriar Foundation about how this footage, and others recently digitized, will be made available for viewing online.







some of those fortunate enough to know him. \$10


Everything Makes Sense: A Close-Notice of Life and Consciousness Tim Garvin




